INSIDE OUT SERVICE UPDATES

As we all have been working to adjust to these unprecedented times of the global COVID-19 pandemic we want to recognize the efforts of all of our amazing and dedicated volunteers and staff. Since our drop-in resource center closed in March, we switched our weekly community group meetings to virtual and support our members primarily from home. In March -June, we worked with 134 individuals, providing reentry services including employment and housing resources, social, emotional and general support.

Even though our drop-in resource center is currently closed, we are meeting with members by appointment. We take the safety of our staff, members, and volunteers seriously, and are closely paying attention to the situation in Iowa. Group meetings, trainings, and forums will continue to be held online until further notice.

CONNECTING WITH INCARCERATED INDIVIDUALS

Due to COVID-19 safety precautions, Iowa correctional facilities are not allowing visitors. As a response, we increased our correspondence to incarcerated individuals. In March - June we corresponded with over 68 individuals.

How to help? With our increases in mailed correspondence, Inside Out could greatly benefit from USPS stamp donations.

CALL FOR MENTORS

Inside Out is looking for volunteer mentors for our members. Mentors correspond with an incarcerated individual who will be reentering the community in order to listen, provide nonjudgemental support and offer companionship. VOTING RIGHTS RESTORATION

lowa is the only state where after a felony conviction an individual automatically and permanently loses the right to vote. Inside Out continues to advocate for the restoration of voting rights for those convicted of felonies.

"I believe I should have the right to vote. I contribute to my neighborhood and economy. I want to feel represented, even if the person I vote for doesn't win. I just want my voice heard." Eric Harris, IO member and voting rights advocate

Governor Kim Reynolds has committed to signing an Executive Order restoring voting rights in Late Summer/ Early Fall. We encourage all of our community to urge the Governor to sign an order with no exclusions and to so as soon as possible so individuals have time to register to vote before the upcoming election.



In February, ten Inside Out members volunteers, and staff attended Iowa Justice Action Network's Lobby Day at the state capital in support of HJR-14, a proposed constitutional amendment to automatically restore voting rights once someone has discharged their sentence. HJR-14 failed to pass by the end of the legislative session.

PARENT CAFÉS AT INSIDE OUT

This Spring, Inside Out hosted a five-week Parent Café series. Parent Cafe's are a safe, nonjudgmental opportunity for parents/caregivers to come together to share and explore various topics focusing on resilience, relationships, support, knowledge and communication.

Some of the weekly themes included: Coping With Stress, Taking Care of Yourself, and Parenting and Technology. We had a great turnout and deep and meaningful conversations were had.

Through the generous support from Theisen's Home, Farm and Auto "More for Your Community" Grant, we provided a family-style dinner, free childcare, and a weekly chance to win a prize that promoted positive family time.
