What is involved in a Backpack Drive?



At these drives, groups will advertise, and collect donations of backpacks and hygiene items. Backpacks are most often requested by men, so male or gender-neutral hygiene products are the biggest need.

What to collect?

Backpack- Standard size
Shampoo and Conditioner
Bar of soap/ Body wash
Wash Cloth
Lotion
Nail Clippers
Deodorant
Toothbrush
Toothpaste
Notebook and Pen

Other items you could include:
